

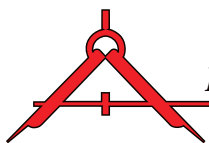
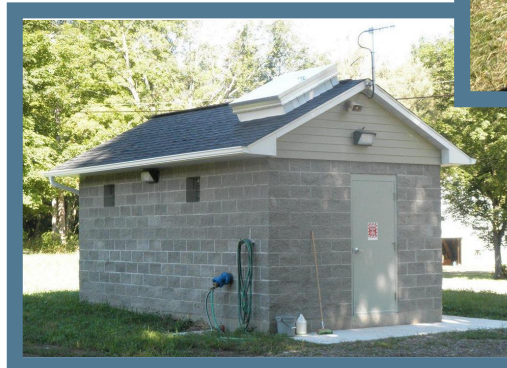
Village of Cherry Creek - Water System Improvements



Location: Cherry Creek, NY
Budget: 2.7 Million
Completion: 2012



The Village's existing water system was becoming increasingly maintenance intensive. The service taps were old and the water mains were becoming prone to leaks. Additionally, the Village's spring supply had been shut down due to Health Department regulations. The Village was in need of a new source, a new storage tank, and extensive distribution system and water service upgrades. This firm assisted the Village in designing a project and putting it together in bidding contracts that were appropriate. We were required to coordinate with regulatory agencies as well as funding agencies on this project. Two new well houses and a glass-fused-to-steel water storage tank were constructed. Extensive distribution upgrades to improve fire flow capacity were also completed. Finally, a telemetry control system and service upgrades were completed.



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
